Day 3: <u>The Victim Experience</u>: Preventing Recidivism in San Diego County.
Day 4: <u>Abuse and Cultural Context</u>: Abuse in Deaf, LGBTQ+, Native American, Disability and Immigrant Communities, and much more.
Day 5: <u>Practice</u>, Implementation, & Role of the Therapist/Facilitator: Law & Ethics, Assessments, Probation Standards of Care, DV Psych-Ed Curriculum. <u>A one-hour lunch and 2 "15" minute break will be given EACH day.</u>
